The railway first opened in September 2010, since then volunteers have been working on the completion of the line to Angel Green which makes a return trip of nearly 2 miles.

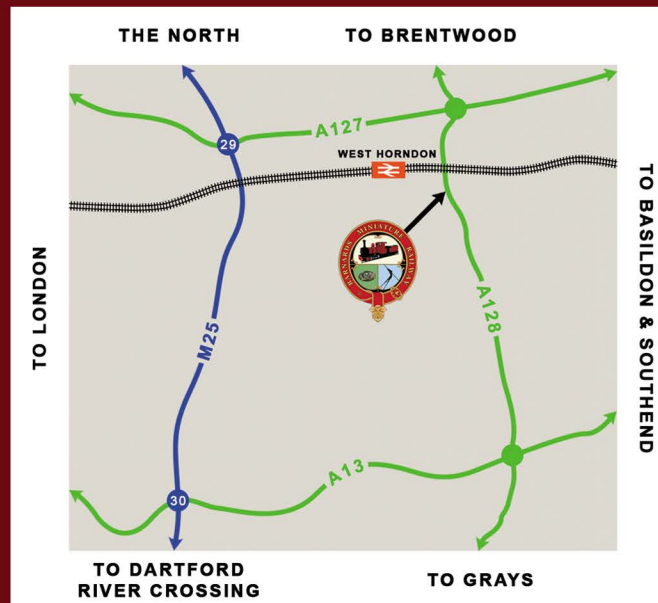


After leaving Burton Shaw the train passes the engine sheds on the right and then travels through woodland and over the Mardyke before entering Belvedere Station. Then passing the runway and through more woodland you will arrive at Sitooterie Halt, located near to the sculpture of the same name nestling on the edge of a lake. Then passing through the tunnel the line curves round over the Mardyke once again for a quarter of a mile up to Angel Green.



Our next project is laying double track between Burtonshaw and Belvedere, and we are also in the process of designing and installing signalling across the line.

HOW TO FIND US



By car:

The BMR is located at Barnards Farm which is on the A128. We are 10 minutes from junction 29 or 30 on the M25, 1 mile south of the A127.

By rail:

The nearest National Rail station is West Horndon served by C2C. There are frequent trains from London and Southend.
